FAIRPORT VILLAGE PARTNERSHIP PRESENTS AN AUDIO WALKING TOUR

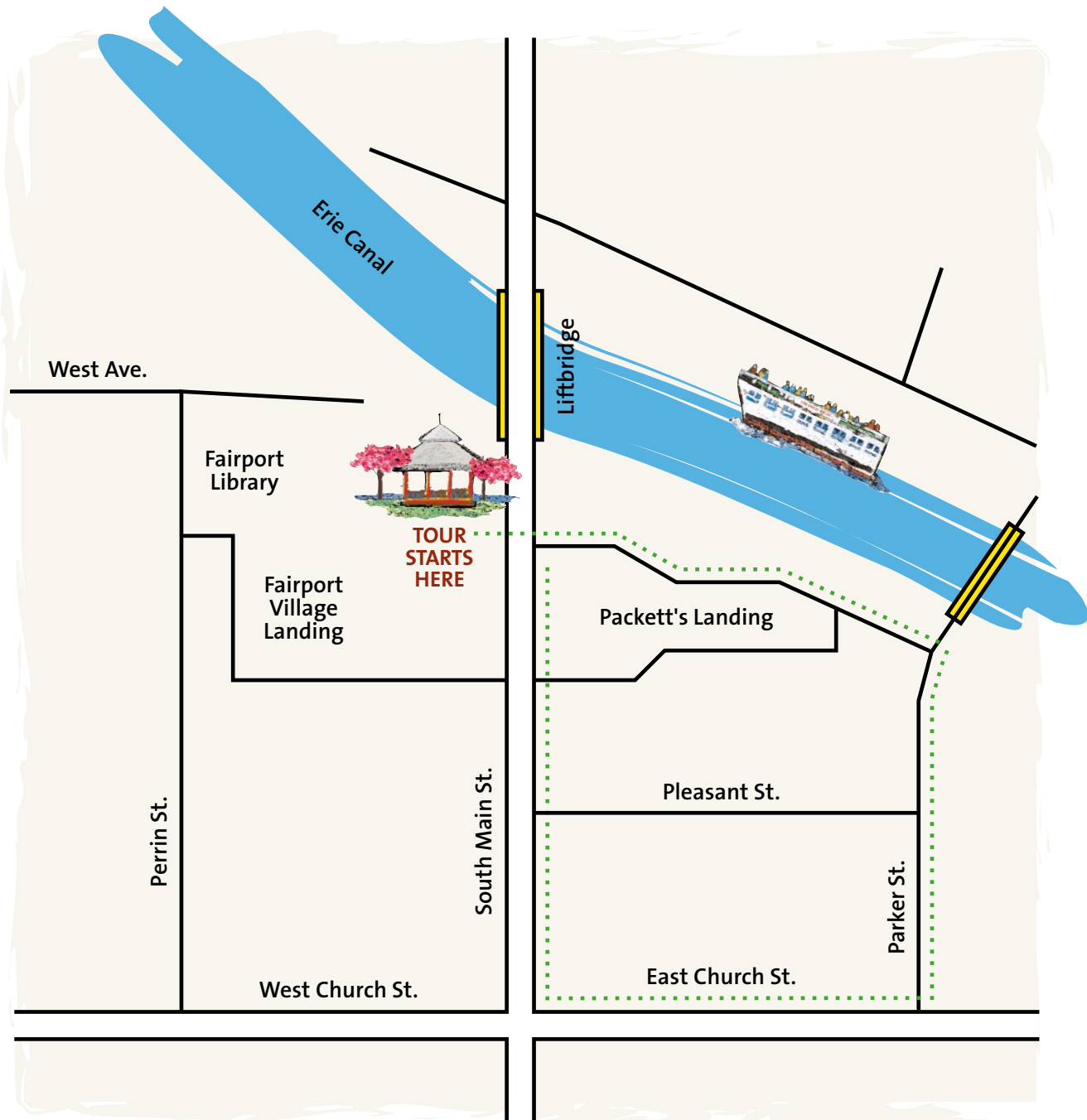
The Fairport Village Partnership sincerely thanks Marilyn and Seymour Rudin for sponsoring this audio walking tour of the Village.
